This is an update to my previous emails about the 2^{nd} series of winter inspections of the high risk category D/C tips in South Wales.

Following the 3rd WG Tip Summit on 22 December (after the Wattstown tip slip on 19 December), we have been asked to provide further assurance that all of the D/C tips have been inspected and the reports have been reviewed.

Following the recent data cleanse exercise we have 294 (D:78 + C:216) inspections to confirm and collect the reports.

We are inspecting 201 of these many on your behalf, which leaves 93 being inspected internally by respective Councils teams.

This is a reminder that we will require copies of these 93 inspection reports by no later than the end of January 2021. This will then enable us to update the inspection matrix prior to forwarding it to the WG Tips Taskforce for assurance.

Next week we will start contacting individual Councils to request copies of these 93 C/D inspection reports.
